OVERVIEW

The dancers will work with class-sized groups of students for 40 minute blocks to explore the WATER CYCLE through shape, energy, line and space. Then the entire grade level will meet together to view a short performance from *Imago* by Alwin Nikolais.

SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

- Two empty spaces for students to dance (empty classrooms, gym, cafeteria, etc.)
- Assembly area (can be one of the areas from above)
- 2 CD players

WORKSHOP SNAPSHOT

- Dancers arrive in school
- 40 min: Dancers split up and work with two classes in empty spaces
- 5 min: transition
- 40 min: Dancers work with one or two more classes in empty spaces
- 5 min: transition (all students move into assembly space)
- 20 min: students view performance
- Students will be involved with dancers for approximately one hour
